**Work-life balance** is the biggest constraint and managing considerations like <u>time</u>, <u>scheduling</u>, and <u>finances</u> affect participation in the community.

The dream multifunctional music-centric space is described as having a diverse range of acts, affordable drinks, and free water. It pays bands well and has a decent sound. The space has low light with posters, raised couches for viewing, and room for standing in the front. It has a punk vibe with old couches and fantastic equipment, allowing for total expressive freedom. The space also includes a recording studio combined with other functionality (could be outlandish like a barbershop and an automotive garage). It is described as <u>interactive and spontaneous</u>, with <u>different areas to explore and a sense that everything fits together perfectly</u>.
